Attached to this email is a CAP Job description of the role and an advert describing the qualities needed, expectations and how to apply.

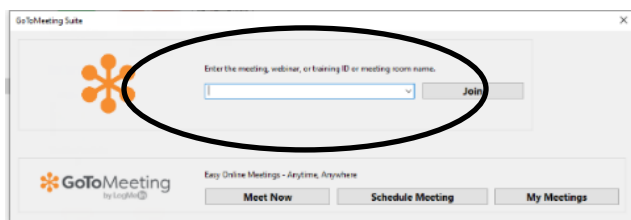
