Volunteers needed to help out at the Vaccination Centres - Communities 1st and partners have been busy recruiting volunteers to support both the vaccination Centres and school Covid testing. Over 2,400 volunteers have now signed up and provided 5,300 hours of support for community vaccination sites in a variety of roles, from stewarding to front of house.
